

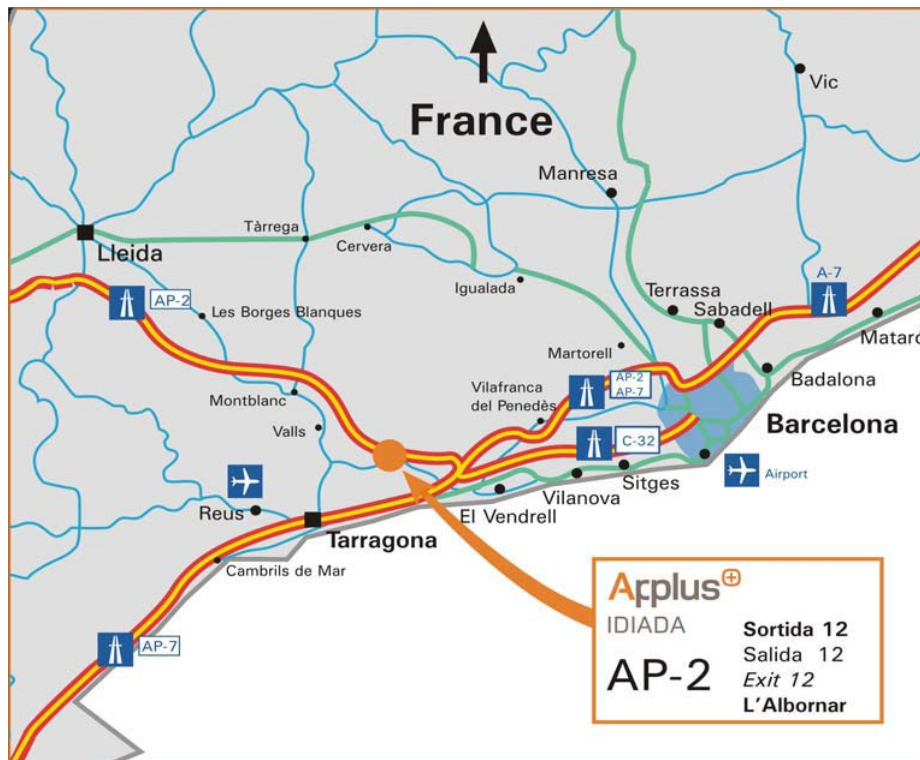

The **SMART Road Restraint Systems** partners have the pleasure of inviting you to the final **project WORKSHOP** taking place on March 14th in Tarragona, Spain at Applus IDIADA technical centre near Barcelona



A full day of sessions, discussions and demonstrations will cover the work conducted in the three-year collaborative project, supported by the European Commission, on developing intelligent and safer road restraint systems.

The collaborative work between ten European partners yielded several breakthroughs in the improvement of the safety of road users in general, and motorcyclists in particular. The cornerstone of the project and main final product, a fully functional smart restraint system using integrated sensors and communication channels to transmit data on road conditions and accidents, will be showcased at the event.

Highlights of the programme include:

- Overview: project rationale, objectives, and the work undertaken
- **Road infrastructure** and motorcyclist safety
- Motorcyclists and guardrails, **the user's perspective**
- A look at **guardrail standardization in Europe**
- **A full scale live demonstration of the working prototype with a motorcycle crash test**
- **A round table** on findings, innovations and future research, featuring the technical team of the project
- **Technical discussions** on accident configurations, injury criteria, simulation, testing protocols, and the evolution of restraint standards and design

Panelists include experts in the field from participating European universities, representatives of the European Commission's Directorate for Research & Innovation, and members of the Federation of European Motorcyclists' Associations who took part in the project.
